- 1. - 3. The identification and background of my firm and the attorneys who were principally involved in this litigation was previously attached as Exhibit 3 to the Joint Declaration of Joseph P. Guglielmo and Gary F. Lynch In Support of Plaintiffs' Unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Settlement and Certification of Settlement Class. *See* ECF No. 61-2.
- 4. The statements and information in this Declaration are based on my review of the Pro-Law accounting records maintained in the ordinary course of business at Carlson Lynch and

from information provided to me from employees working under my supervision and control. The purpose of the review was to confirm the accuracy of the information, as well as the necessity for, and reasonableness of, the time and expenses committed to this Action. The time reflected in my firm's lodestar calculation was necessary to perform the pre-suit investigation and the litigation of this action to this favorable resolution. I believe that the time reflected in the firm's lodestar calculation and the expenses incurred were necessary for the resolution of the litigation.

5. Carlson Lynch has spent 465.8 hours litigating this Action and 1,073.5 hours investigating it. In preparing the lodestar chart below, I excluded any individual who billed less than 10 hours on this matter. The firm's lodestar totals \$403,862.50.
